Dear Parents / Carers

Our cluster of schools (Barlby CP, Barby Bridge, Cliffe, Escrick, North Duffield and Riccall) are holding a cluster sports day on Tuesday 16th May, run by our Sports organisers 'Sporting Start'. The event will take place at Barby CP School.

The event, which involves rounders, football, VX and athletics, will take up the full day and every child in Key Stage 2 (year 3 / 4 / 5 / 6) is taking part.

Children will be transported to the event by coach and we will leave school at 9.15am, so please ensure children arrive at school promptly to allow time for registration. We expect to return to school by 3pm.

Children will need:

- To come to school dressed in PE kit- white t-shirt, navy or black shorts/leggings, trainers plus their school jumper / cardigan.
- Raincoat, sunhat, suncream (to cover all eventualities!)
- Children involved in football will also require shin pads and boots (no metal studs) - we will let children know who this applies to
- Children will require a packed lunch for this day, any school meals booked for this day will be cancelled. Please indicate on the form if your child is in receipt of free school meals and you wish school to provide a packed lunch
- Children will also require plenty of water (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please)

Children will be informed about which sport(s) they are involved in. Unfortunately, there will not be space for parents to watch the event due to the very large numbers of children attending.
