**WHAT IS A CONTINENT?**

**Continents** are large areas of land.  
**Continents** contain many countries.

**Asia** is the largest continent. It has the biggest **land area** and the world's biggest **population**.

- Southern Ocean**


4. Which is the biggest ocean?

**WHAT IS AN OCEAN?**

Oceans are very large expanses of sea.

There are 7 continents:

- Oceania / Australia**
- North America**
- South America**
- Antarctica**
