1. Can you name some or all of the 7 continents and locate them on a map?

WHAT IS A CONTINENT?

Continents are large areas of land.
Continents contain many countries.

There are **7** continents:

- Africa**
- Asia**
- Europe**
- Oceania / Australia**
- North America**
- South America**
- Antarctica**

5. Which continent do we live in?

England is in **Europe**

2. Which is the biggest continent?

Asia is the largest continent. It has the biggest **land area** and the world's biggest **population**.

3. Can you name some or all of the 5 oceans and locate them on a map?

There are **5** oceans:

- Pacific Ocean**
- Atlantic Ocean**
- Indian Ocean**
- Arctic Ocean**
- Southern Ocean**

4. Which is the biggest ocean?

WHAT IS AN OCEAN?

Oceans are very large expanses of sea.

DID YOU KNOW ...?

The **Pacific Ocean** is the largest ocean - it covers almost **1/3** of the Earth's **surface!**
